The first Wednesday in May is the night to remember those who have died as a result of domestic and family violence right across the country. These simultaneous vigils of remembrance began in Queensland in 2005 with the 15 member organisations of the

Queensland Domestic Violence Services Network (QDVSN) hosting candle lighting ceremonies at 6pm throughout Queensland.

Progressively since 2010, the vigils have been held in other states and 2012 saw every state and territory in Australia joining Queensland.
